

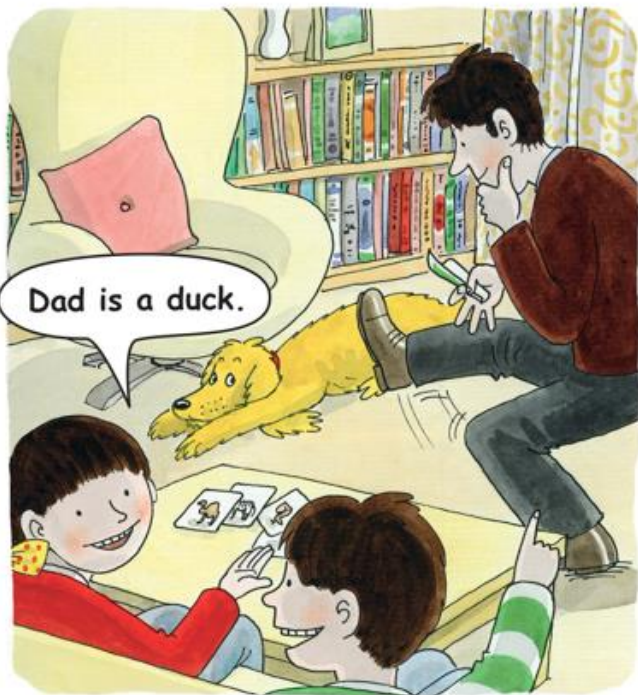

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AFTER READING

Code for /k/

- Look for all the words which, when spoken, have a /k/ sound.
- In this book, which letters make the /k/ sound?

WHAT IS BLENDING?

For reading (decoding) say the sounds from left to right of the word and blend the sounds to hear the whole word.

How to blend

Point under each letter or letter group as you say the sound, then run your finger under the whole word as you say the whole (or blended) word.

e.g. **qu-i-z** **quiz**



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Was Dad right?

Do chickens say "quack quack"?

Play the game with your family, what animal will you describe?

Can you recall what animals were in the story?

Writing:

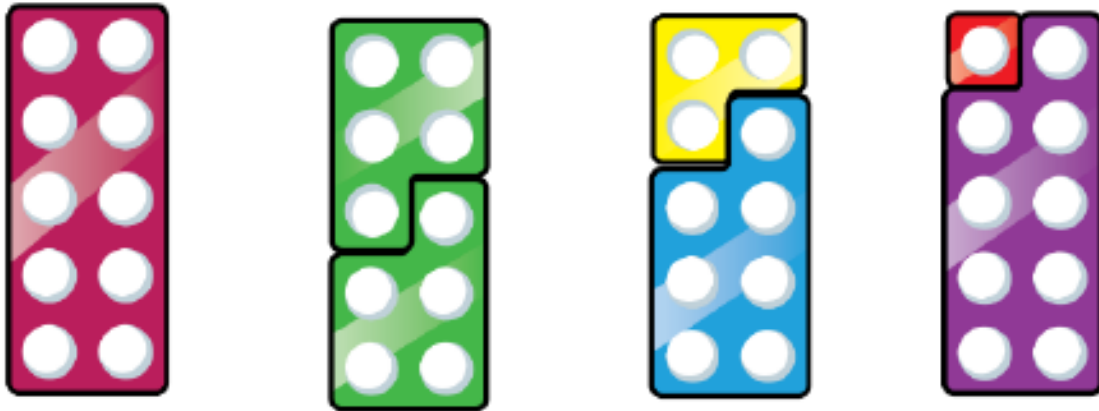
